### Which Level of Government Do I Contact?

#### **Provincial and Municipal Responsibilities**

#### Contact your municipal office about:

- preparing for a flood what to do to protect your property
- getting sandbags and volunteers to build dikes
- information about emergency evacuation orders
- evacuation where to go, help with evacuating
- local road closures and detours
- pumping water out of basements
- concerns about dikes failing or needing to be raised
- draining water from buildings and property
- digging ditches for drainage
- access to diked property during evacuation
- when it's safe to return to your property
- applications for Disaster Financial Assistance program
