



2026 CRSB AGM Student Sponsorship

The Canadian Roundtable for Sustainable Beef (CRSB) is pleased to announce its third annual **Student Sponsorship!**

Two graduate students will be selected to present their research at CRSB's Annual General Meeting (AGM), providing a valuable opportunity for students to engage and network with leaders and industry representatives from across the beef value chain.

When: August 18, 2026

Where: RBC Convention Centre, Winnipeg, MB

The 2026 CRSB AGM will be taking place during the Canadian Beef Industry Conference (CBIC). Full conference dates include August 18th-20th, with an optional tour on the 17th.

Two graduate students will receive sponsorship for the following:

- **August 18 (CRSB AGM):** Students will present their research on stage.
- **August 19:** Students will compete in the 2026 CBIC Poster Competition.
- **August 20:** If placed in the top 3 of the Poster Competition, students will deliver a 3-minute presentation on the CBIC main stage to compete for cash prizes.

Selection Process

- Abstract Submission Deadline: **June 1, 2026, at 11:59 PM MT** [\[SUBMIT HERE\]](#)
- Applicants will be shortlisted based on their abstract submissions.
- Selected candidates will advance to a second-round interview conducted by the CRSB's Scientific Advisory Committee.

What is included in the Student Sponsorship?

Successful applicants will receive coverage for CRSB/CBIC registration, hotel accommodations, and a travel allowance to attend the CRSB AGM and CBIC.

Requirements

Applicants must:

- Be a current graduate student enrolled at a Canadian academic institution.
- Be conducting research focused on or related to beef sustainability.
- Research can be applicable to any area of the supply chain.
- Be available to attend the Annual General Meeting and Canadian Beef Industry Conference August 18th-20th, 2026 in Winnipeg, MB.
- Submit an abstract into the CBIC Poster Competition and participate August 19th-20th ([Submit CBIC Abstract Here](#)).

CRSB Abstract Requirements

Research must be focused on or related to beef sustainability. Topics can be applicable to any area of the supply chain (from farm to fork) including, but not limited to ruminant nutrition, ecology, biodiversity, food safety, on-farm safety, crop science, food waste, soil science, economics, animal science, rural community development, etc.

- **Word limit:** Maximum **350 words** (excluding the title).
- **Title:** Must be concise, relevant to a producer audience, and no longer than **25 words**.
- **Keywords:** Include **five** keywords that reflect the primary themes of your abstract.
- **Objective:** The **first sentence** must clearly state the main objective of the work.
- **Methodology:** Provide essential experimental or program details, such as:
 - Population or sample
 - Experimental design
 - Housing or environmental conditions (if applicable)
 - Data collection procedures
 - Statistical analyses performed
- **Results:** Present results that directly address the stated objective, including appropriate statistical inferences.
 - One table or figure may be included if it is the most effective format for presenting results.
- **Conclusion:** Provide a clear conclusion outlining the effectiveness and/or practical application of the results.
- **Authorship:** The submitting student **must** be the presenting author.
